- ❖ Travis Wooridge – Insurance Representative discussed with us the benefit and increase of Life Insurance signed up!! 2010 Annuities are up over \$100M from 2009. Paid out to beneficiaries \$243M in 2010. Dividends Paid Out \$318M in 2010. \$106M to the Pope for his Charities from the Vicarious Christie Fund. With KofC Insurance being up overall across the country and Canada, Insurance is down over 20%.
