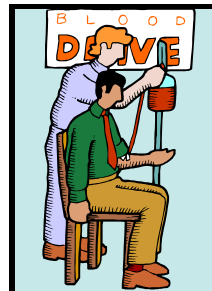

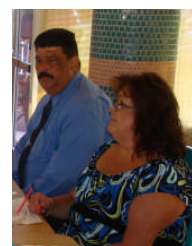

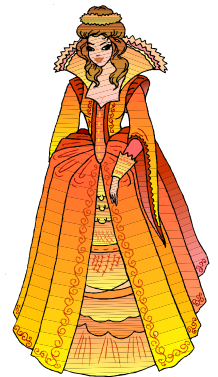

## RECIPE OF THE MONTH

### Mojito

4-5 mint leaves  
1 teaspoon of white sugar  
2 table spoons of lemon juice  
1 ½ oz of white rum  
3 oz club soda



In a tall glass, place mint leaves and sugar, using a pestle or the end of wooden spoon lightly smash the mint leaves and sugar together.

Add the lemon juice and rum and mix until sugar is dissolved. Add ice cubes and club soda to fill glass. Garnish it with a small mint sprig. You can adjust the taste by cutting or adding more of each ingredient.

If you are making a large batch, just multiply the ingredients (mint leaves, sugar, lemon juice and rum) by 10x or 20x, mix all the ingredients, let them sit for a couple of hours. Strain the mixture and just pour into glasses, add ice and club soda to taste.

### Pineapple Mojito

4 mint leaves  
2 teaspoons of white (granulated) sugar  
2 tablespoons of lemon juice  
2 oz of pineapple juice  
1 ½ oz of light rum  
Splash of Club Soda

Follow the steps above to mix.

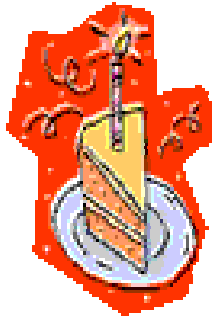
