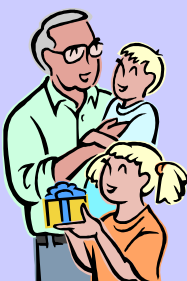

Brother Robert is also on the Memorial to the Unborn committee, which is responsible for the maintenance of the memorial in the courtyard at St. Paul the Apostle Church.



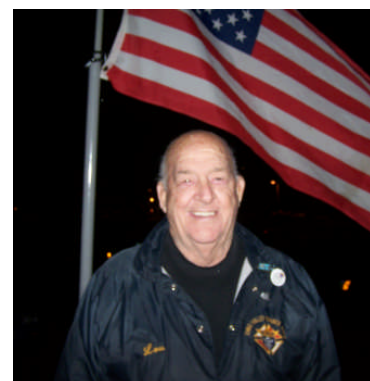

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Pumpkin Dessert Squares

1 box yellow cake mix
1 jar Muirhead Pumpkin Pecan Butter
3 eggs
1 tablespoon of flour
1/4 cup sugar
3/4 cup butter
3 tablespoons milk
1 teaspoon cinnamon



Reserve 1 cup of the cake mix and set aside. Mix remaining cake mix with 1/2 cup of melted butter and 1 egg. Press mixture lightly into the bottom of a 13x9 inch pan. Mix 1 jar of Muirhead Pumpkin Pecan Butter with 2 large eggs and 3 tablespoons of milk and pour over cake mixture in pan. Mix to a crumble, reserved cake mix with 1 tablespoon of flour, 1/4 cup of sugar, 1/4 cup of soft butter and 1teaspoon of cinnamon - crumble over the top of the pumpkin layer.

Bake 35-40 minutes at 350 degrees or until golden. Cool and serve.
